

PRIVACY STATEMENT

The Combined Services Provider Ltd ('CSP') respects privacy and your rights to control your personal data. Our principle guidelines are simple: we will be clear about the data we collect and why; your data is sacredly protected by us; we do not, and will not, sell your data to third parties.

This Privacy Statement (the 'Statement') explains the personal information we collect from you, either directly or indirectly, and how we will use it. The personal information we collect

Why: We use this information to share news about events and products and services offered by CSP. Additionally, the IP address helps us to understand geographic information about our website visitors better so that we can improve our website for everyone.

How we use personal information

CSP uses the data we collect to provide you with the services we offer. We also use the data to communicate with you, for example, informing you about your account, new products or services available, security and other types of updates.

Sharing and disclosure

CSP does not, and will not, sell personal information about our customers. We only disclose your data as authorised in this Statement. We only share information with third parties for the

purposes of delivering services you have contracted for. All such data processors are subject to a duty of care under Article 28 of the General Data Protection Regulation.

Our policy towards children

CSP does not target and is not intended to attract children. CSP does not knowingly solicit personal information from children or send them requests for personal information.

Our retention of personal data

CSP retains personal data for as long as necessary to provide services and fulfil the transactions you have requested, or for other essential purposes such as complying with our legal obligations and resolving disputes and enforcing our agreements. Because these needs can vary for different data types in the context of different services, actual retention periods can vary significantly.
